EMA – County approval to appoint Denny Burtloff as the townships EMA is still at County level. State Colleges radar is down at present for repairs.

New Business: Lycoming County Register and Recorder David Huffman attended the meeting to inform and educate the public about the services the office offers. Supervisor Johnston made a motion to get a sign to be put out by the recycling bins that state no plastic bags to be put in bins must dump contents out seconded by Supervisor Raudenbush (MCU). Frontier pole and lines that have come down on Big Run Road has been reported several times and we have the ticket numbers Frontier has still not made the repairs the EMC will reach out on his end to try

and get Frontier to make the necessary repairs to their property as it is interfering with the township road.

Old Business: Worker compensation resulted in a return premium due to payroll being a little lower.
